Dear Pace family member:

Pace University's spring 2024 registration is now underway. To ensure that your student is prepared for next semester, please read the following information outlining billing deadlines bland our nonpayment process.

The spring bill payment will be due January 4, 2024. This means that your student must finalize financial arrangements to satisfy their bill before this date. Students who have not arranged payment by January 4, 2024, will be charged a late fee, and anyone with an account not in good standing will be dropped from Spring 2024 semester classes for nonpayment as of January 10, 2024.

To be ready to meet this important deadline:

- Students should register for spring 2024, if they have yet to do so.
- Access spring 2024 bill via the <u>Student Payment Portal</u> within 48 hours of registering. If applicable, financial aid will be credited to the bill within a business day of registration.
- If applicable, provide any forms or documents to Financial Aid.
- Review payment arrangement options on Pace's <u>payment information</u> <u>webpage</u>. Enroll in a spring payment plan before the fall semester ends to spread your payments over all months available.

If your student needs assistance with resolving challenges, we're offering dedicated in-person support at our upcoming pop-up Student Solutions Centers. No appointment is necessary.
